### Guidelines on submission criteria

One of the key objectives of the “EU Aquaculture website” is to provide relevant and up-to-date knowledge information on **aquaculture-related resources and events** in the context of the implementation of the “Strategic Guidelines for the sustainable development of EU aquaculture”.

In order to submit information on resources or events, please complete the form available on the website, ensuring your submission meets the following criteria:

#### 1. Types of content

For the Knowledge base you can share the following types of content:

- EU legislation and relevant international instruments.
- Guidelines.
- Good practices and experiences on aquaculture.
- Aquaculture-related European projects.
- Reports.
- Scientific papers and publications.
- Learning materials on EU sustainable aquaculture (e.g. tutorials, training material, e-learning modules).

For the events page you can share:

- Competition and award ceremonies
- Conferences and summits
- Exhibitions
- Info days
- Partner meetings
- Political meetings
- Public debates
- Training and workshops
- Visits
- Expert meetings
- Campaign launches

#### 2. Timeframe

The key objective is to collect resources from **reliable and recognised sources** published from **2019 onwards** and **events scheduled for the next 12 months** whether in a physical location or online.

### 3. Geographical coverage

The resources or events should cover at least one of the EU27 Member States. Additionally, key information from three non-EU countries (i.e. Norway, Iceland and UK) is also welcome.

### 4. Final considerations

You can submit several contributions by filling in the online form for each contribution that you wish to submit.
